

THE CONSTITUTION

PURPOSE OF THE CONSTITUTION

"The express purpose of the Constitution of the United States of America is to govern the government, not the people. It is a contract between the people and the government, a government created by the will and act of the people. The government is not greater than the people who created it. The creator is greater than its creation.

The Constitution sets forth principles, agreements and laws whereby the government is limited, prohibited, restrict-

ed, and restrained in its various functions, actions and responsibilities to the people. The purpose of those inhibitors are to guide, lead and direct the government to prevent it from acting against the Godgiven and unalienable rights of the people."

Our Creator-God endowed us with certain "unalienable rights," rights that are not alienable, not transferable, not estranged, usurped, given away, seizable. They are rights that are inviolable (not to be violated, profaned, injured, broken, taken away, but God-given rights that are to be kept sacred.

THE DECLARATION OF INDEPENDENCE (JULY 4, 1776)

The Declaration of Independence, 1776, appeared only eleven years before the Constitution of the United States was drafted and dated (1787). In The Declaration, our Founding Fathers declared that the source of their unalienable rights was the Creator. The Declaration was the source and substance the Founders of our Republic used in writing the Constitution. In the first paragraph, The Declaration speaks of "the laws of nature and of nature's God." In the second paragraph, The Declaration states, "We hold these truths to be self evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable rights, that among these are Life, Liberty, and the pursuit of happiness."

The statements of these two paragraphs reveal that the Founders believed there were fixed laws of nature established by nature's God and that all men are created, having a Creator who endowed them

with certain inalienable rights. This laid the foundation and chief cornerstone for the Constitution and the Bill of Rights.

TO UNDERSTAND THE CONSTITUTION IS TO UNDERSTAND THE REPUBLIC

"The Declaration of Independence, which underlies the Constitution, holds that the rights of the people come from God, and that the powers of the government come from the people. Let me repeat that: According to the Declaration of Independence, the rights of the people come from God, and the powers of the government come from the people. Unless you grasp the basic order of things, you'll have a hard time understanding the Constitution." — Joseph Sobran, News columnist, article: How Tyranny Came To America.

Our God-given unalienable rights include our right to (1) life, liberty and property, (2) freedom of speech and press, ((3) peaceable assembly, and to petition the government for a redress of grievances, (4) to secure our persons, houses, papers, and effects against unreasonable searches and seizures with no warrants used except upon probable cause, describing the place to be searched and the persons or things to be seized, (5) speedy and public trial, (6) freedom of travel, (7) freedom of religion, (8) own and run our own business, (9) defend self, others and property including the right keep and bear firearms, (10) not to be spied upon.

The difference between a constitutional republic and a democracy is the difference between liberty and slavery. This is aptly pointed out by even Ira Glasser, former Director of the nefarious American Civil Liberties Union:

"Even in a democracy the majority must be limited in order to guarantee individual rights and personal autonomy. If whites have more votes than blacks, they cannot be allowed to deny blacks their constitutional rights. If men have more political power than women, that cannot permit them to deny women certain individual rights. Winning an election should not permit the victors to assemble their votes and enact laws or govern in a way that strips those who lose of their liberty."

When a lady asked Ben Franklin, "What kind of government have you given us, Sir?" Franklin replied, "A Republic, if you can keep it." We have not kept it. Hardly a day goes by that some politician (not statesman) or journalist refers to the U.S. as a democracy and sounds its praises as such. Turn over in your grave, Ben!

Since the loss of our constitutional republic, we have confiscation of property without trial, secret arrests, imprisonment without conviction, government spying on its citizens (shades of Hitler and Karl Marx), torture of prisoners and foreign invasion to impose "democracy" (nation building) by force.

To return to sanity and biblical principles of just government, we must abandon the imperious dogma of democracy and restore a true constitutional representative government in order to achieve a nation of freedom, individual liberty and the attending blessings of God.

QUESTION: Since when are the people's individual rights subject to majority vote, or political usurpation?

ANSWER: Since America ceased to be a constitutional Republic and became a Democracy.

"The whole of the Bill [of Rights] is a declaration of the right of the people at large or considered as individuals ... It establishes some rights of the individual as unalienable and which consequently, no majority has a right to deprive them of." — Albert Gallatin of the New York Historical Society, October 7, 1780.



"...To understand these concepts 'will of the people' and 'representative republic' we must understand the law as it was intended for our form of government. It is mandatory to read commentaries by Coke, Kent, and Blackstone to understand that the system of government known as a 'representative republic' is not based on 'the will of the people.' but on the will of the God of Abraham, Issac and Jacob. Only if the will of the people coincides with will of God should it be considered in the 'rule of law.' If you understand this, then you can understand Romans 13. God's law is based on His will.

The representatives were chosen by the people because they were trusted men of God who could discern His will and rule accordingly. The term 'representative' has its reference back to the will (mind) of God and not the people. When Franklin made his comment about keeping the republic that was established, he knew very well that the people could go astray. I believe the federalists, led by Hamilton, were very careful not to disregard the concerns of the anti-federalists. That is why Hamilton enlisted Madison to compile the papers." — Greg Peck, Rural Ohio, The Electoral College and the Rule of Law, Letters to the Editor, The New American, February 12, 2001.

DEMOCRACY IS A DICTATORSHIP

"A democracy is a dictatorship over the minority by majority rule. A republic is a free society guaranteed by constitutional law, whereby we are governed by the Constitution and not by what the majority may demand. In a Constitutional Republic, the whim of the majority, or government leaders, cannot touch a minority of even one person in his life, liberty or property except by perversion of the law or administration." — Ron Cowan



Kill the Messenger?

On June 11, former Rep. Ron Paul (R-Texas) told Fox News he's concerned the U.S. government will assassinate Edward Snowden, the gutsy 29-year-old whistleblower who leaked information about top-secret National Security Administration (NSA) snooping programs. "I'm worried somebody in our government might kill him with a cruise missile or a drone," Paul said on the Fox Business Network. "I mean we live in a bad time where American citizens don't even have rights and that they can be killed, but the gentleman is trying to tell the truth about what's going on."

Whistleblower Sacrificed All to Expose Police State Abuses Edward Snowden, the man who exposed the vast NSA data collection program, is running for his life.

America needs another hero—and we have one, a man who has the nation's top brass in a panic. Even now their clean-up teams are hunting down whistle-blower Edward Snowden, 29, a mid-level intelligence contractor, for the "crime" of exposing PRISM—a data collection effort known officially as US-984XN.

PRISM, a supercharged version of an illegal Bush- era program that secretly spied on U.S. citizens, is a secret intelligence program run by the National Security Agency (NSA). PRISM has the ability to gob-

ble up millions of phone calls, emails, Internet chats, online file transfers—even login notifications.

AFP readers have long known about invasions of our rights similar to the government's PRISM operation in collusion with multinational corporate Internet giants. These private companies included some of the biggest, such as Microsoft, Yahoo, Google, Facebook, America Online, Skype, Youtube and Apple.

Why did Snowden give up everything to become a demonized, penniless fugitive in a strange land? In interviews with mainstream publications,

Snowden said that after 9-11, while still in his teens, he volunteered for the Special Forces, in 2003. "I wanted to fight in the Iraq war, because I felt like I had an obligation as a human being to help free people from oppression," he told The Guardian, a British liberal newspaper. "[However,] most of the people training us seemed pumped up about killing Arabs, not helping anyone."

After breaking both legs in a training accident, he was medically discharged from the Army. Still wanting to serve America, Snowden went to work for the NSA. Next, he worked for the CIA in information technology security. By 2007, while under diplomatic cover in Geneva, Switzerland, the criminal hypocrisy of the CIA—so contrary to America's ideals—demoralized him. "Much of what I saw in Geneva really disillusion me about how my government functions and what its impact is in the world," he was quoted by The Guardian as saying. "I realized that I was part of something that was doing far more harm than good." He was appalled, he said, that while "sitting at my desk [I had the power to] wiretap anyone, from you, or your accountant, to a federal judge, to even the president."

In 2008 Snowden "believed in Obama's promises." But Barack Obama "advanced the very policies I thought would be reined in." In 2009, Snowden left the CIA, to work for NSA private contractors. The disillusioned patriot, horrified by the choice: "You can get up every day, go to work. You can collect your large paycheck for relatively little work against the public interest and go to sleep at night after watching your shows; or refuse to live in a society that does these sorts of things. You can't wait around for someone else to act. . . . I am not afraid, because this is the choice I've made."

Snowden knew the price he would pay. At best, he would lose his "very comfortable life," his \$200,000 salary, his girlfriend with whom he shared a home in Hawaii, a stable career and the family he loves. He would be smeared as a traitor. He risked imprisonment, torture and death.

"I'm willing to sacrifice all that because I can't in good conscience allow the U.S. government to destroy privacy, Internet freedom and basic liberties for people around the world with this massive surveillance machine they're secretly building," he told *The Guardian*.

"There are more important things than money," he said. "If I were motivated by money, I could have sold these documents to any number of countries and gotten very rich.... My sole motive is to inform the public as to that which is done in their name and that which is done against them."

Alone, he carefully planned. He contacted a few journalists he hoped he could trust under the codename Verax, which means "true" in Latin. He offered an exclusive to *The Washington Post*. According to *the Post's* Barton Gellman, Verax warned him that until the articles were published, the journalists working with him would also be at risk from the U.S. intelligence community, because they "will most certainly kill you" if they think that would stop the dis- closure from being published.

Apparently Snowden wasn't aware that since the 1950s, the CIA has "owned" the major news media—and *The Washington Post* was the CIA's flagship ever since Operation Mocking Bird. *The Post* kept stalling and didn't publish the scoops. So Verax told them the exclusive news offer was off.

Snowden then gave Glenn Greenwald of *The Guardian* in the UK permission to break the story. Greenwald and Ewen MacAskill secretly flew from London to Hong Kong—the safest place on Earth for a

fugitive NSA whistle-blower—to interview Snow- den for this story.

Snowden gave *The Guardian's* Greenwald per- mission to disclose Verax's true identity, because "I have no intention of hiding who I am because I know I have done nothing wrong."

At Dulles Airport, Washington-based foreign affairs analyst and editor at large of *The Atlantic*, Steve Clemons, overheard, photographed and re- corded four men who had attended an intelligence conference in honor of former NSA director Michael Hayden and chaired by former Ambassador John Negroponte. One of them said that Greenwald and Snowden should be "disappeared."

When he raised his right hand in the manner of Khruschev the applause began. Standing behind him is the Rev. Dr. Theodore F. Adams, pastor of the First Baptist Church, Richmond, Virginia, president of the Alliance.

At the close of the session the pastor of the First Ukrainian Baptist Church of Sao Paulo, Brazil, said, "The red on that flag is the blood of my people." Jakov Zhidkov, leader of the Russian delegation, was re-elected vice-president, and Artur Mitkevich was made a member of the executive committee of the Baptist World Alliance. Zhidkov gave a message at the Congress, "The Lord of Peace," in which he represented the leadership of the Soviet Government in its declarations for universal disarmament before the United Nations, September 1959, "as dear to the hearts of all Christians, as dear as are the words of the Bible in the Book of the Prophet Isaiah 2:4."

Nikita Khruschev said, July 5, 1960, in Vallach, Austria: "Life is short, and I want to see the Red Flag over the whole world in my lifetime."

Editor's note: At the time of this meeting, the Southern Baptist Convention was a member of the Baptist World Alliance. Isaiah 2:4 mentioned by Zhidkov states: "And he shall judge among the nations, and shall rebuke many people: and they shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruning hooks: nation shall not lift up sword against nation, neither shall they learn war anymore."

Our Communist enemies use religion and misuse the Bible for ungodly tyrannical gain. This verse is in reference to the thousand year (millennia) reign of Christ and not with disarming na-

tions for a one world order (communist/socialist) dictatorship. Zhidkov's speech "The Lord of Peace" reminds me of Karl Marx statement, "The meaning of peace is the absence of opposition to socialism."
