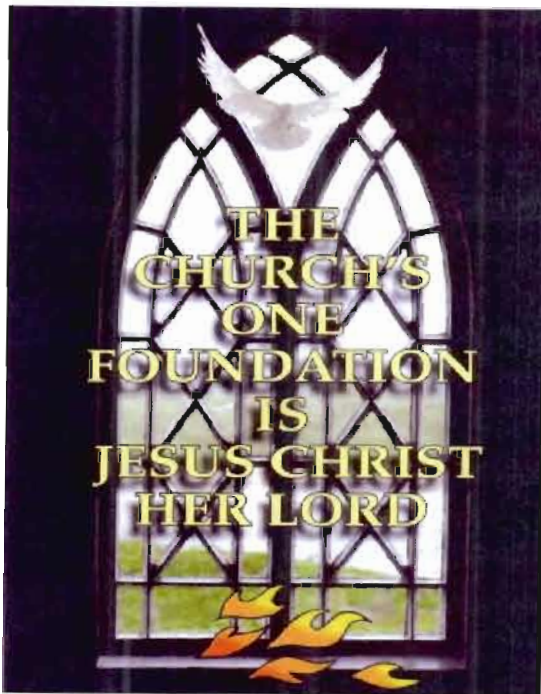

10 LANDMARK DECISIONS (Enough is Enough)

10 landmark U.S. court decisions that have undermined Christian and family values:

- 1) June 22, 1962 *Engel v. Vitale*: The Supreme Court restricts prayer in schools.
- 2) January 22, 1973 *Roe v. Wade*: The Supreme Court finds that the right to personal privacy includes abortion.
- 3) November 17, 1980 *Stone v. Graham*: The Supreme Court strikes down a Kentucky statute requiring display of the Ten Commandments in public schools.
- 4) June 30, 1994 *Madsen v. Women’s Health Center*: The Supreme Court upholds the creation of so-called “buffer zones” around abortion clinics, severely restricting pro-life free speech.
- 5) June 26, 2002 *Newdow v. U.S.* : The 9th U.S. Court of Appeals rules that reciting the Pledge of Allegiance in public schools is an unconstitutional endorsement of religion.
- 6) June 28, 2003 *Lawrence v. Texas*: The Supreme Court strikes down a Texas law prohibiting sodomy.
- 7) June 27, 2005 *McCleary County, Ky v. ACLU*: The Supreme Court rules that the display of the Ten Commandments in a state courthouse exhibit entitled “The Foundations of American Law and Display” is unconstitutional and must be removed.
- 8) November 2, 2005 *Fields v. Palmdale School District*: The 9th Circuit rules that parental rights to control their children’s education “does not extend beyond the threshold of the school door.”
- 9) February 4, 2008 *Rachel L. et al v. Superior Court of California*: California’s 2nd District Court of Appeals rules that it is illegal for parents who do not have teaching credentials to home school their own children.
- 10) May 15, 2008 *Marriage Case*: The California Supreme Court declares same-sex “marriage” legal in California, overturning a statewide initiative that defines marriage as exclusively between a man and a woman....Copied

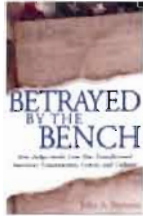

MAJORITY RULE VERSUS RULE OF LAW

CONSTITUTIONAL RULE OF LAW, OR ARBITRARY RULE OF TYRANTS

“How can the meaning of the Constitution -- the fundamental law -- be so unpredictable? Stability is the essence of the rule of law in general; unpredictable edicts, flowing from the arbitrary will of rulers (whether they are called kings, dictators, presidents, legislators, or judges), are typical of tyranny. But Americans today are resigned to being told what to do. They accept arbitrary, unpredictable rule as normal. In fact much of our politics consists of organized attempts to manipulate the law by buying the favor of the rulers. This corruption became so flagrant during the Clinton years that many people want to stop it by limiting campaign spending. But the problem arises not from campaign donations, but from the very nature of the government. If it were strictly limited to its constitutional powers, it couldn’t bestow many favors and wouldn’t be worth buying. But when its powers are arbitrary and boundless, the inevitable result is an auction of bribery. And the more venal the politicians, the more they will pretend to be public benefactors and philanthropists, feeling our pain.” — Joseph Sobran

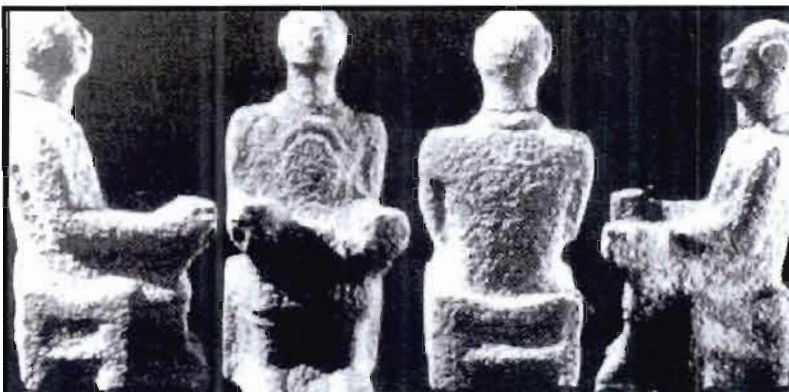

WHAT EVERY AMERICAN OUGHT TO KNOW ABOUT THE MUSLIM RELIGION

CALIFORNIA DEMOCRATIC PARTY ELECTS MUSLIMS

CAIR — The California Democratic Party recently elected 28 muslim delegates and alternatives. This is the largest number of Muslims ever elected as delegates to a political party in the U.S.

ARAB IDOLOTRY

Arabs, in their idolatry, worshiped 360 pagan gods at the Kabah in Mecca. The moon-god was the chief deity in their idolatrous worship. Mecca was in fact built as a shrine for the moon-god. This made Mecca the most sacred site of Arabian paganism. Muhammad decided that Allah the moon-god was not only the chief, supreme deity, but that it was the only god.

The Muslim's false claim that Allah is the God of the Bible and that Islam arose from the religion of the prophets and apostles is refuted by solid, overwhelming archeological evidence. Islam is nothing more than the ancient moon-god cult of idolatry. ***Allah is a pagan god from pre-Islamic times.*** Archaeologists have uncovered temples to the Moon-god throughout the Middle East. This pagan idolatry was practiced in Ur of the Chaldees, from which God brought Abram (Abraham) [Genesis 15:7; Nehemiah 9:7]. It was practiced in Mesopotamia, by Assyrians, Babylonians and others as discovered by archeologists.



The crescent moon is the symbol of Islam sitting on top of their mosques and is found on the flags of Islamic nations. The Muslims fast during the month which begins and ends with the appearance of the crescent moon in the sky. The idolatrous pagan Arabs worship the moon-god idol praying toward Mecca.

God, the Creator of Heaven and Earth, God of the Old and New Testaments, God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, is the one and only true God, condemns idolatry:

- “Flee from idolatry.” (I Corinthians 10:14).

- “Keep yourselves from idols.” (I John 5:21)
- “Ephraim is joined to idols: Let him alone.” (Hosea 4:17).
- “Thou shalt not bow thyself down to ... any graven image.” (Exodus 20:4,5).
- “Idolaters... shall have their part in the Lake of fire which burneth with fire and brimstone.” (Revelation 21:8).

God condemns idolatry in Israel and commanded punishment by death in the Old Testament:

Deuteronomy 17: 2--5: *“If there be found among you, within any of thy gates which the LORD thy God giveth thee, man or woman, that hath wrought wickedness in the sight of the LORD thy God in transgressing his covenant. And hath gone and served other gods, and worshiped them, either the sun, or moon, or any of the host of heaven, which I have not commanded: And it be told thee, and thou hast heard of it, and enquired diligently, and behold, it be true, and the thing certain, that such abomination is wrought in Israel: Then shalt thou bring that man or that woman, which have committed that wicked thing, unto thy gates, even that man or that woman, and shalt stone them with stones till they die.”*

The Old Testament constantly rebuked the worship of the moon-god. When Israel fell into idolatry, it was usually the cult of the moon-god. As a matter of fact, everywhere in the ancient world, the symbol of the crescent moon can be found on seal impressions, steles, pottery, amulets, clay tablets, cylinders, weights, earrings, necklaces, wall murals, etc. In Tell-el-Obeid, a copper calf was found with a crescent moon on its forehead.

OBAMACARE AND MEDICAID

The ObamaCare law expands Medicaid, the joint state and federal programs which provides nearly 50 million low-income Americans, including about one-third of all children. The federal government (taxpayers) provide the money to the states, which administers the program.

The new Obama law makes millions of additional Americans eligible by raising the level of income they can earn and still qualify. That addition is expensive. The federal government (taxpayers) will pay the cost of this expansion. However, by 2020, states (who are for the most part currently bankrupt) will pay all additional costs of covering more people. Thus, the federal government expansion of Medicaid is unconstitutional because it is an unfunded mandate, telling the states to add services without providing money to do so.

The court issued a limited ruling, that the federal government could expand the Medicaid program, but that it could not take away current funding if the states chose not to participate in the new [Obama] program. The court upheld the constitutionality of the individual mandate, so there is no need to separate it from the rest of the law.

The black robbed tyrants of the U.S. Supreme Court could have declined to issue a ruling on the grounds that the law had not gone into effect.

**ANTI-GUN MOVEMENT
FOCUS ON INSURANCE**

The movement against guns is now focusing on trying to raise insurance rates on gun owners. Their aim is to force gun owners to jump through liability loops to get gun insurance.
